



#### **AAK EVENTS BETWEEN JULY AND AUGUST**

#### 1.URBAN THINKERS CAMPUS ACTIVATION DAY: 14TH JULY

On Friday, the 14th, the association hosted a highly successful event, where we actively engaged with members of the public throughout the day. The event, Urban Thinkers Campus activation day, centered around the theme of "smart, sustainable, and just cities."

During this event, we also conducted two significant public awareness campaigns. "Je Una Mjengo?," which aims to shed light on the issues of unsafe and unhealthy buildings in Kenya. This campaign seeks to raise awareness about the importance of safe construction practices.

The second campaign, "Mulika Mjengo," is an initiative led by the Architectural Association of Kenya (AAK), with the primary goal of empowering the public to identify and report potentially hazardous construction sites. By involving the community in this effort, we hope to enhance construction safety across the country.

With these two campaigns, the association is dedicated to continually sensitizing the public throughout. Recognizing the significance of fostering awareness about the issues related to urban development and construction safety, we will engage in various activities and initiatives to keep the public informed. Our commitment to raising awareness remains steadfast, and we look forward to making a positive impact on the community's well-being.





#### 2. CPD BUILD TOUR: MERU AND ISIOLO 28TH AND 29TH JULY

The quantity surveyors chapter hosted a successful build tour in Isiolo and Meru. The tour included visits to three important sites:

Isiolo International Airport: Participants explored the passenger terminal's design, which focused on an intuitive layout, convenient facilities, robust security measures, and accessibility for passengers with disabilities.

The apron facilities were also examined, emphasizing strategic design for aircraft parking, taxiways, and ground handling services. Moreover, tailored considerations for target flights, including aircraft specifications and passenger amenities, were highlighted.

Potato Cold Storage Aggregation Center at Ntugi Market: This site showcased eco-friendly solutions with rendered and plastered walls made from straw.

The innovative construction techniques promoted sustainable and green building practices, emphasizing the commitment to environmentally friendly solutions in the construction industry.

Silver Spread Hardware Ltd - Pipe Manufacturing Factory: The participants visited a factory in Meru town specializing in manufacturing uPVC, PPR, and HDPE pipes. The tour covered the production processes involved in creating these pipes, including extrusion, sizing, cooling, cutting, and pipe joining methods.

Participants learned about the unique properties and applications of the pipes, such as durability, heat resistance, and flexibility, as well as the quality control measures and industry standards maintained by the factory to ensure reliable and high-performance pipes.





# 3.THE EAST AFRICAN INSTITUTE OF ARCHITECTS (EAIA) ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING AND TRIENNIAL MEETING AT MÉSTIL HOTEL & RESIDENCES IN KAMPALA UGANDA ON SATURDAY JULY 27 – 29, 2023.

The East African Institute of Architects Annual General Meeting and the inaugural Triennial Congress hosted by the Uganda Society of Architects took place on 27th through to 29th July 2023 under the theme of the event was "Design for Resilient Communities". The association was represented through the Architects chapter who also took part in exhibiting diverse content during the triennial.



#### 4. KISUMU CITY CAR FREE DAY

AAK exhibited the projects we have been undertaking including the Grow A Classroom project, Safari Green Building Index, IFLA Convention, 3IF, and the Healthy Homes Guidelines and Checklist at the Kisumu County Car Free Day held on 8th July 2023. It was an incredible event that brought together individuals from various sectors working towards creating a more sustainable and people-friendly city, including school-going children who were asked to express their vision for the city through drawings.







#### **MEETINGS & ENGAGEMENTS**

#### AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROGRAMME (AHP) FORUM

AAK was invited by the State Department of Housing and Urban Development (SDHUD) to undertake the following activities to support the AHP:

- The Framework for Engagement of Consultants for Affordable Housing which provides a structure for the government in engaging Built environment consultants in offering professional services in the design and supervision of the AHP.
- MoU between Architectural Association of Kenya (AAK), Institute of Quantity Surveyors of Kenya (IQSK), and the Institution of Engineers of Kenya (IEK) which leads to the creation of the AHP Forum which will advise the government and influence the various industry players in matters of affordable housing.
- MoU between SDHUD and the professional bodies that will provide a framework of collaboration between SDHUD and the FORUM (AAK, IEK, and IQSK) to support successful delivery of the Affordable Housing Programme in Kenya.

#### **AAK AT THE INTERNATIONAL UNION OF ARCHITECTS (UIA) CONGRESS 2023**

AAK exhibited and had a delegation at the UIA World Congress from 2nd to 6th July 2023. During the congress, AAK presented activities to "Leave no one Behind" which included the Inclusive and Integrated Infrastructure Framework for Kenya (3If), Grow A Classroom project to develop better learning environments for public schools, the Safari Green Building Index a homegrown rating tool for the tropical climate, the Je, Una Mjengo? campaign for professionalism in the built environment and Healthy Homes Guidelines for improving existing housing stock to be decent and safe spaces.



### NATIONAL SYMPOSIUM ON DESIGNING AND COSTING OF AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROJECTS

On 13th July 2023, AAK took part in the National Symposium on Designing and Costing of AHP. AAK President Arch. Florence Nyole moderated a key panel during the session and some of the critical issues raised were the need to reduce over-designing, leveraging affordable building materials, and the need to introduce sustainable standards.



## MEETING WITH CECM BUILT ENVIRONMENT AND URBAN PLANNING, NAIROBI COUNTY

On 11th July, Architects met with the Nairobi County Executive Committee Member for Built Environment and Urban Planning, S. G. Mwangi, and the officers to discuss development control invoicing and payments processing challenges.



## KENYA MEDICAL ASSOCIATION ON THE SOCIAL HEALTH INSURANCE BILL, DIGITAL HEALTH BILL, FACILITY IMPROVEMENT FUND BILL AND PRIMARY HEALTH BILL

The Kenya Medical Association is participated in important legislations that have been tabled in parliament, that have been adopted by government to shape the drive to Universal Healthcare in Kenya. The body that will take over from National Health Insurance Fund (NHIF) will go by the name Social Health Authority (SHA). It was thus important to have representation of professional associations in the bills process and in SHA.

On behalf of the health sector, and professional associations, The Kenya Medical Association (KMA) submitted memoranda and sufficiently justified that KMA should be on the SHA Board. KMA took part in public participation on the bills on 5th of September 2023 at the Weston Hotel, an event that was organized by the Ministry of Health and attended by the PS Health PS Harry Kimtai. KMA also made public submissions on the same bills to the senate team that hosted a public participation meeting in Turkana County.

KMA is pleased to note that the Act has proposed to retain KMA as one of the board members of the Social Health Authority that will be charged with administration of the funds collected for social health insurance and primary health. KMA is thus the representative of APSEA in the SHA.
