## APSEA CHAIRMAN'S FOCUS AREAS

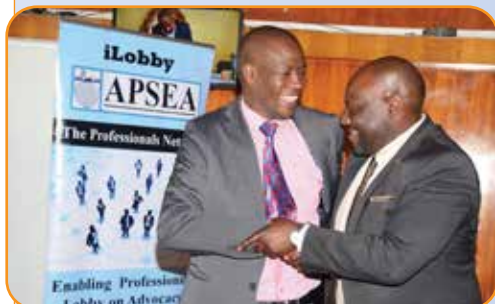
**My vision for our Association is centered on four Key Pillars:
