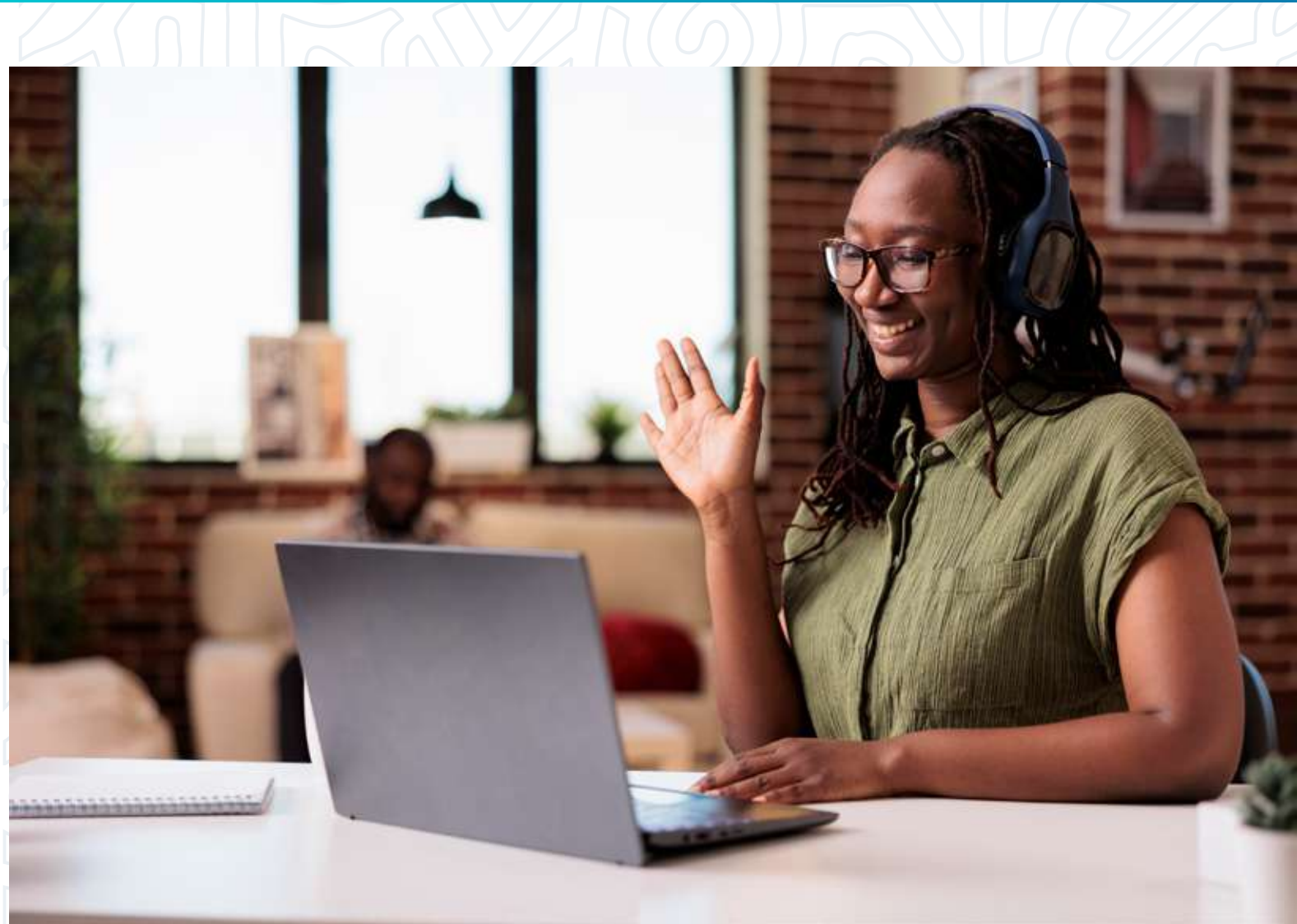

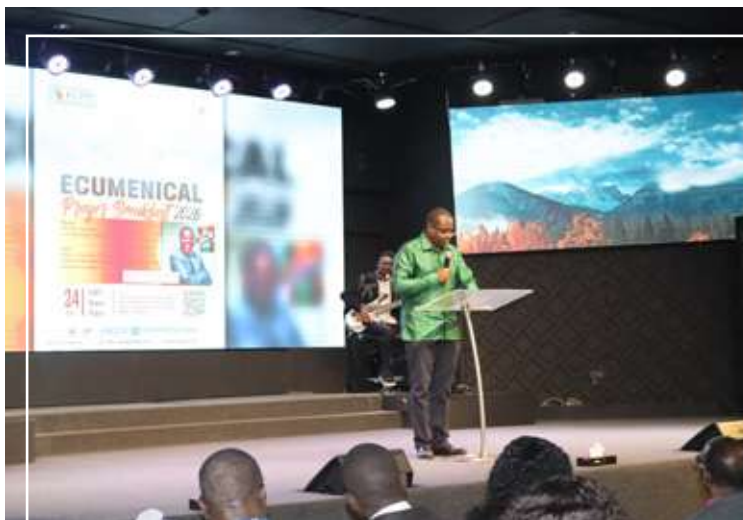

7th ENGINEERING PARTNERSHIPS CONVENTION MEDIA LAUNCH

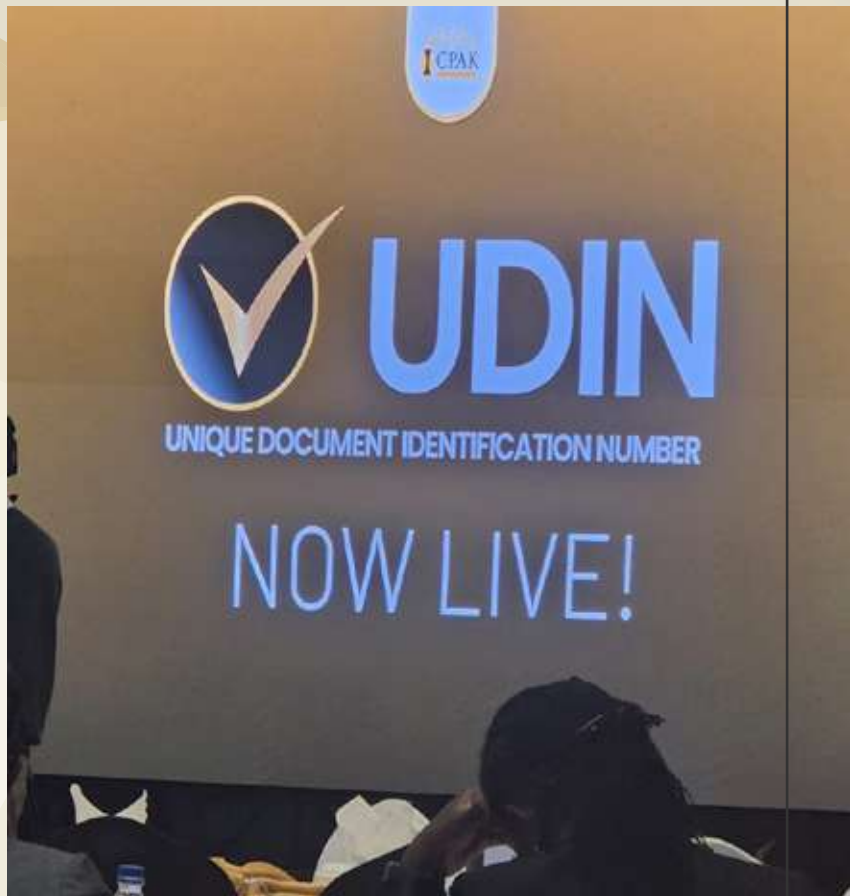
